The top scoring finishers, male and female, will be awarded Athletic Scholarships valued at \$2000 each.
All other scholarships are valued at \$1000.
13 scholarships are available in total.

- CHS graduating senior
- Student athlete, trainer, or manager
- 3.0 GPA or Higher
- Letter of acceptance into a college, university, post-secondary, accredited trade school or Military Academy

 - Athletic Scholarships: 12 Available
 - Outstanding Citizen Scholarship: 1 Available
- Application must be received on or before the due date to be valid. **2025 DUE DATE: May 24th**

Scholarship winners will be notified by the Chelmsford High School All Sports Booster Club at the conclusion of the spring sports season by email to the address provided.

This often occurs after graduation in early to mid June.

The winners and their parent/guardians will be invited to our Booster Scholarship & Awards Banquet (mid June, final date TBD) to be recognized and to collect the scholarship check.
